We've included a simple game to test your ability to identify engines by their sound, as well as an animation to help appreciate the construction of a Chris Craft boat.



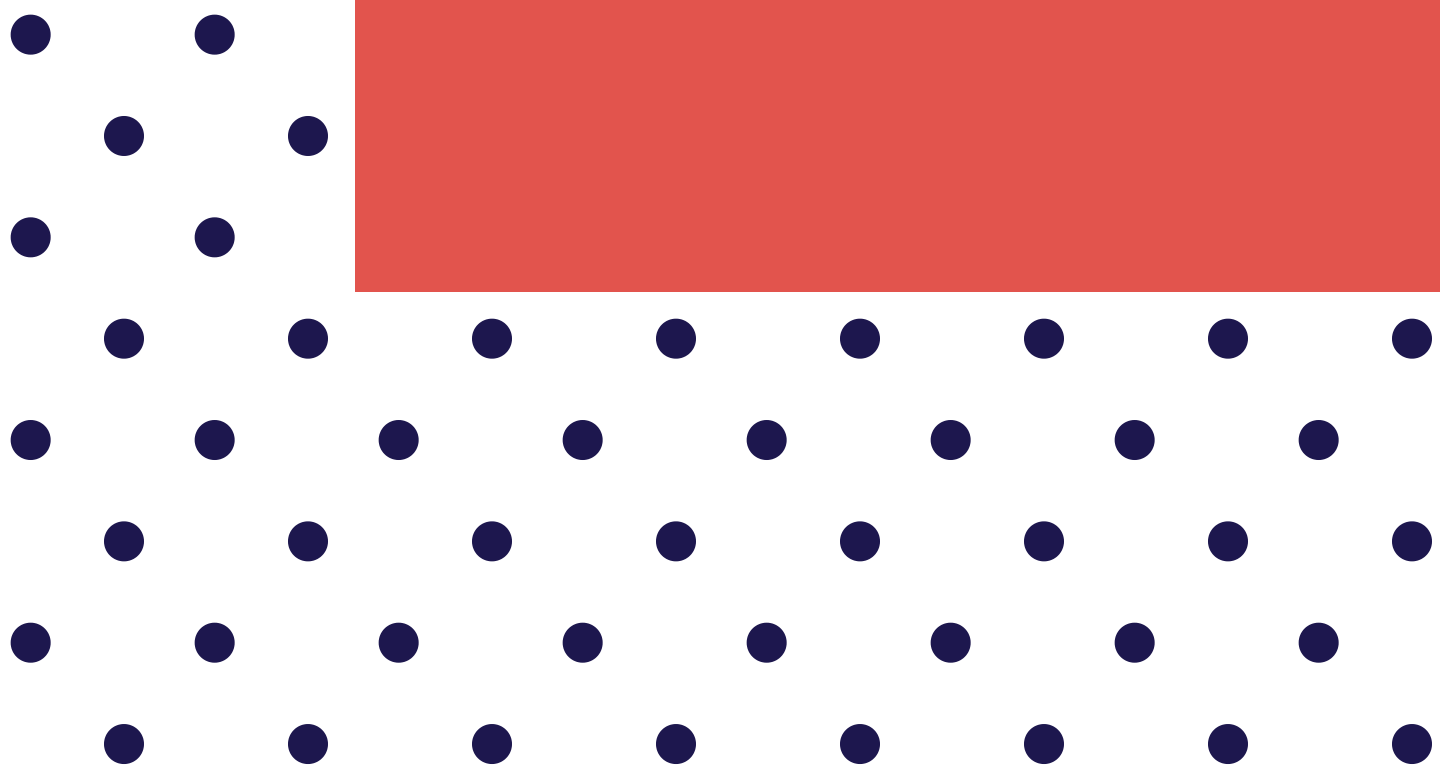

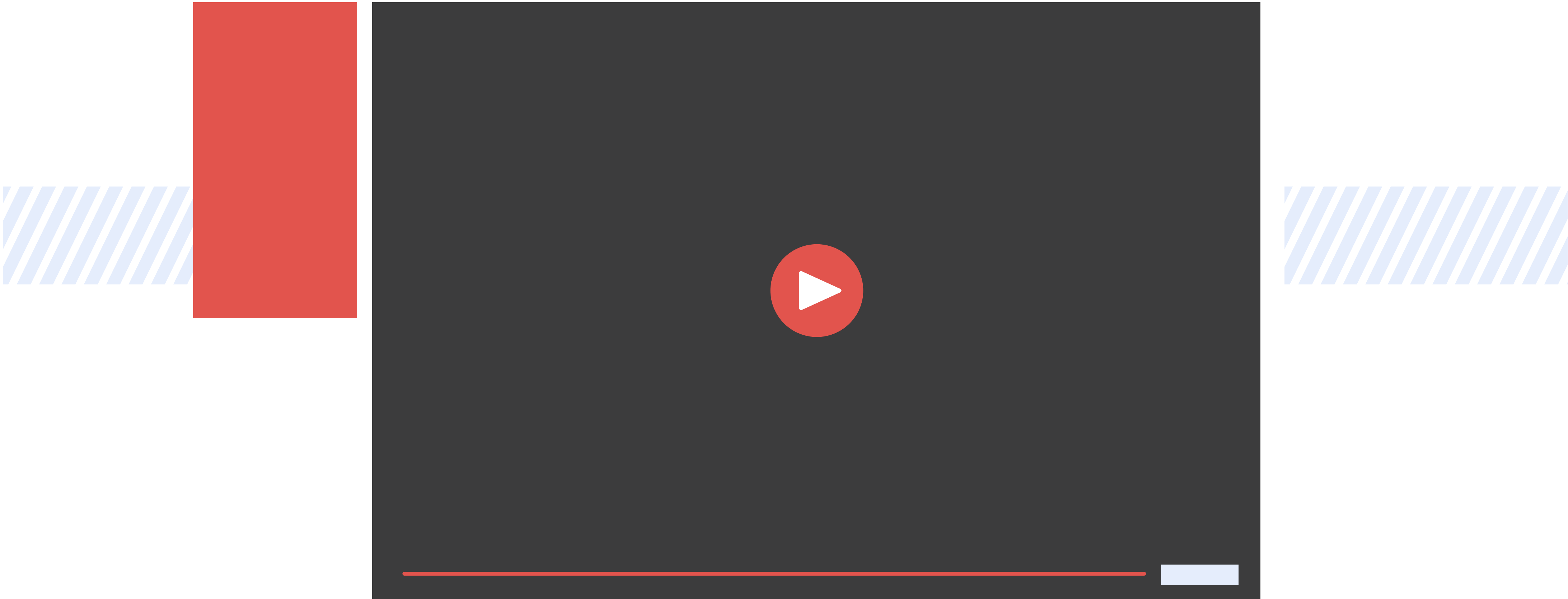
